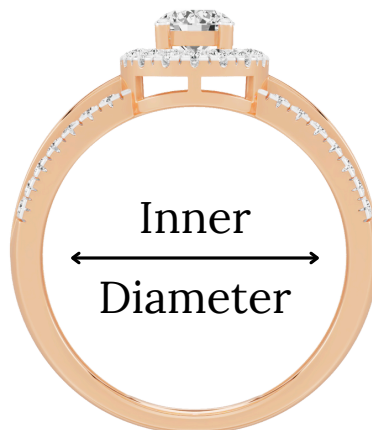


How to Measure Your Ring Size



Option 1: Measure an Existing Ring

- Take a ring that fits comfortably on the intended finger.
- Measure the inner diameter using a ruler (in millimetres).
- Match your measurement with our size chart below.



Option 2: Measure Your Finger

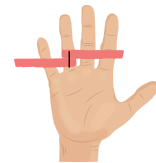
Step 1: Cut a thin strip of paper or use a soft measuring tape.



Step 2: Wrap it around the base of your finger (not too tight or too loose).



Step 3: Mark the point where the paper overlaps.



Step 4: Measure the length in millimetres and compare it with our size chart.
